FISH WEIGHT COMPETITIONS

If you are a member and have 'caught the big one' have it weighed. There are two competitions running side by side during the year.

Each month there is a Fish of the Month (see calendar of events on the membership page for details) and all who catch one of the fish of the month species goes onto the All Rounder Board. Points are awarded for the heaviest down to the 'hey, you caught one' accordingly. At the end of the year the points are tallied to see who the All Rounder is for the year catching a diversity of fish from river to sea.

The second competition runs all year round and it is who has caught the heaviest of each species by the 30th June.

Sections include MENS, LADIES, BOYS and GIRLS.

All fish are to be weighed at an official weigh station.

These include:

- · Eden Amateur Fishing Club Inc clubhouse at Quarantine Bay, Eden.
- Eden Outdoor and Marine in the main shopping centre in Eden.
- · Matildas Shop n Go at the top of the hill as you head south out of Eden.
- $\boldsymbol{\cdot}$ Kiah General Store on the highway 12 minutes drive south of Eden.
- · Wonboyn General Store 33kms south of Eden in the beautiful village of Wonboyn.
- · Shell Bait & Fuel Service Station Betka Road, Mallacoota, Victoria.
- · Alpine Angler Snowy Mountains Highway, Cooma.

It is the responsibility of every angler to make sure their fish receipt is correct when weigh in occurs. All weighdockets are valid for two months only.

PRESIDENT'S REPORT

Greetings Members

A crowd of over eighty gathered for the January seafood feast, a daunting prospect for our catering and cooking team but as always they rose to the occasion in style. Thanks team and thanks also to those who brought along another great array of salads and sweets.

Double fish of the month presentation: The December whiting was dealt with first and Emma Inge took out the Junior section with April Paterson the runner up. Jenny Rugg, crook hip and all, was the best of the ladies while Deb Cummings had a go to be runner up.

A couple of big game fishers got among the larger Slimy Maccas to win the senior sections, Gloria Sebley taking the women's with 0.430 kg effort from Deb Cummings. She also claimed bragging rights over husband Geoff who could only manage 0.405 kg but this was still

good enough to win the men's section.

We are now well into the Sand Flathead month but you will have until the 28th to get one and the prize will be presented at the March BBQ.

Fishing Competition: It is now only days away and there is still much to be done. In the lead up we need assistance on the following days:

Friday Feb 21st: We will display our main prizes in Imlay Street and sell entries and raffle tickets etc.

Saturday Feb 22nd: Working bee at the clubhouse and we will be in the main street again.

Thursday Feb 27th: Selling entries etc. in the main street once more.

Friday Feb 28th: Selling entries at the clubhouse all day and preparing for the briefing night BBQ.

Throughout the week of the comp we need people to man the clubhouse each day, the enclosed roster sheet sets out times. It can be filled in and returned to the president or you can put your name on the board at the clubhouse on the working bee day or briefing night.

Working Bee: This involves a general clean up of the building, inside and out, and on top.
